

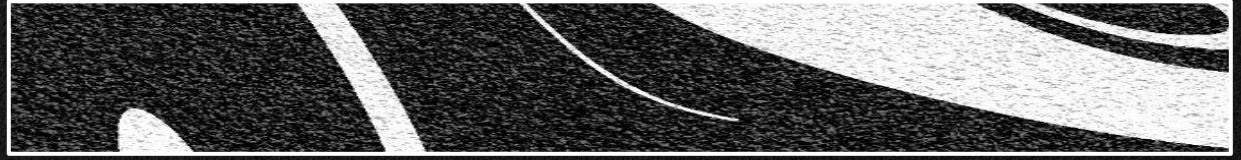

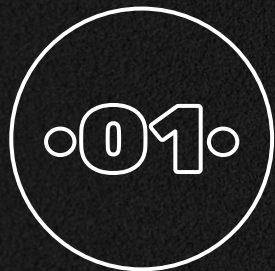

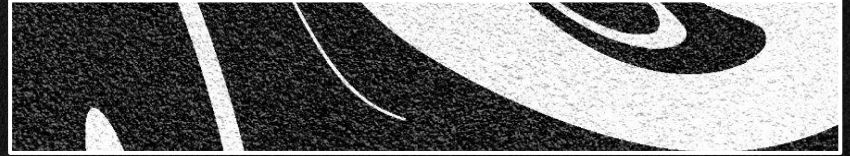


The Process!

Finding Sources:

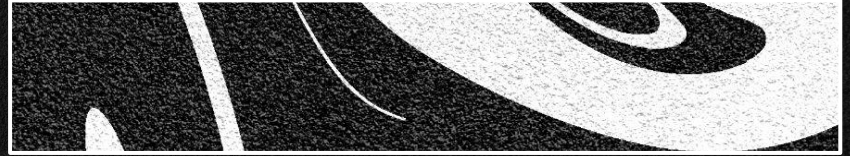
I did a lot of work trying to find sources during January and February, and managed to secure six definitive sources, though, in the end, I accrued three more.

This would be a critical portion of my project, as it would be the base of all my work to come.



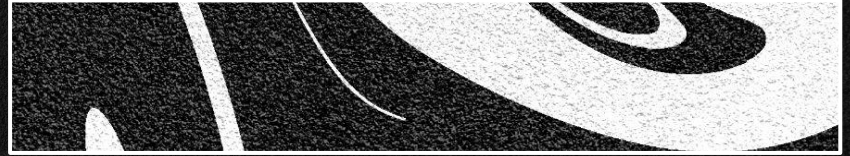
Research

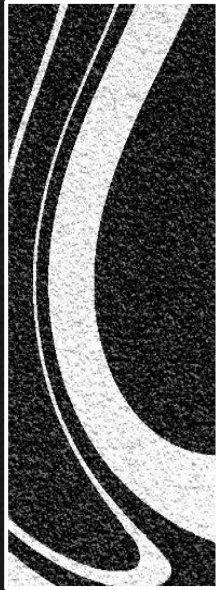

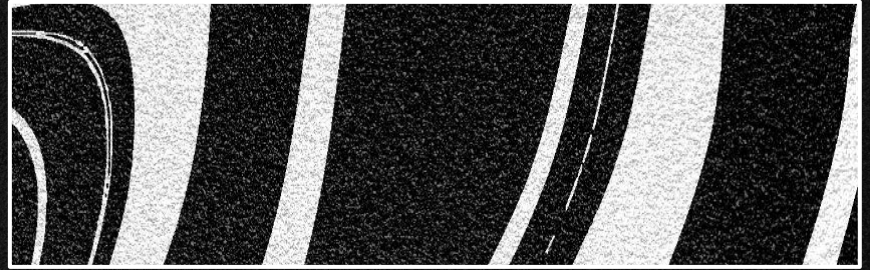


Challenges & Growth
