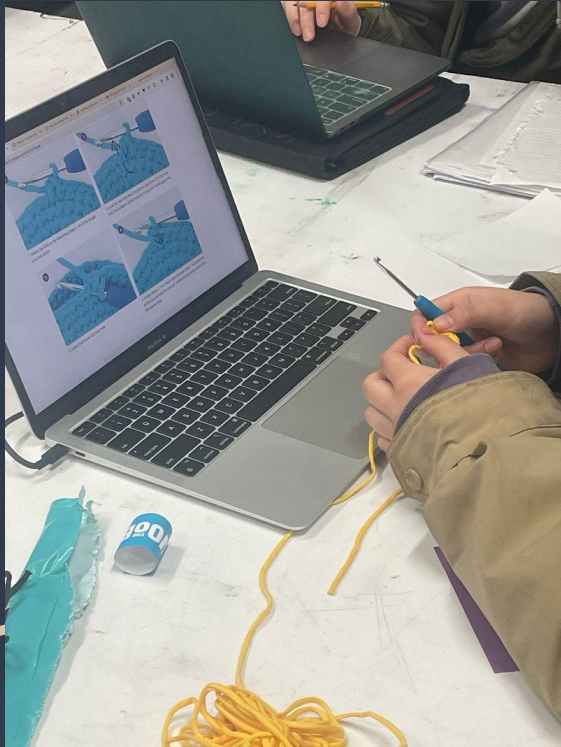


Making crochet stuffies to donate
